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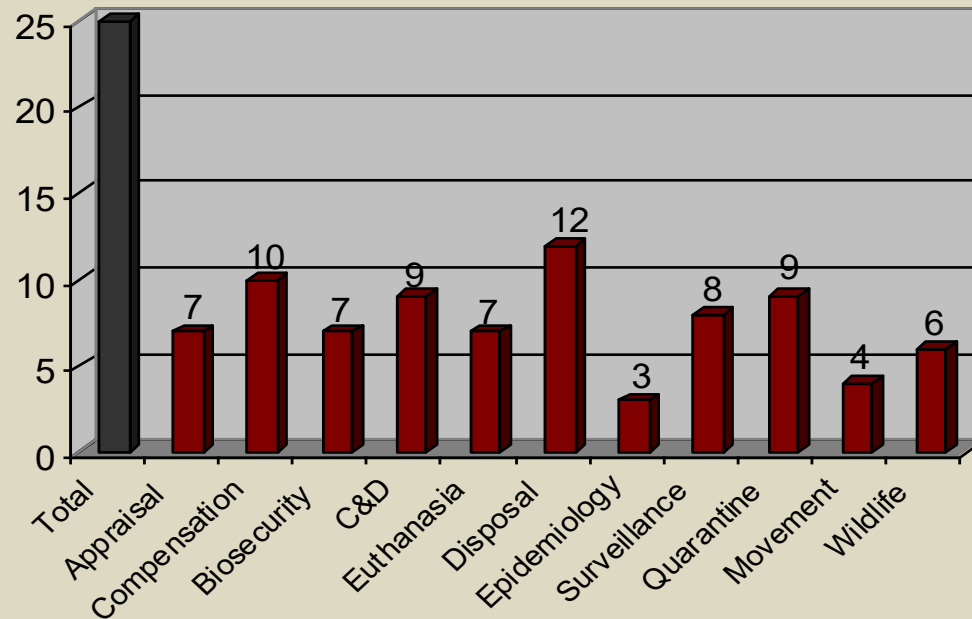


# Homeland Security Presidential Directive 9

## Line Item 15

(15) The Secretary of Homeland Security, in coordination with the Secretaries of Agriculture, Health and Human Services, the Attorney General, and the Administrator of the Environmental Protection Agency, shall **develop a coordinated agriculture and food-specific standardized response plan that will be integrated into the National Response Plan.** This plan will ensure a coordinated response to an agriculture or food incident and will delineate the appropriate roles of Federal, State, local, and private sector partners, and will address risk communication for the general public.

# OHA FAVD Branch Volunteer Scholar Project 2011– State Animal Disease Response Plan Review

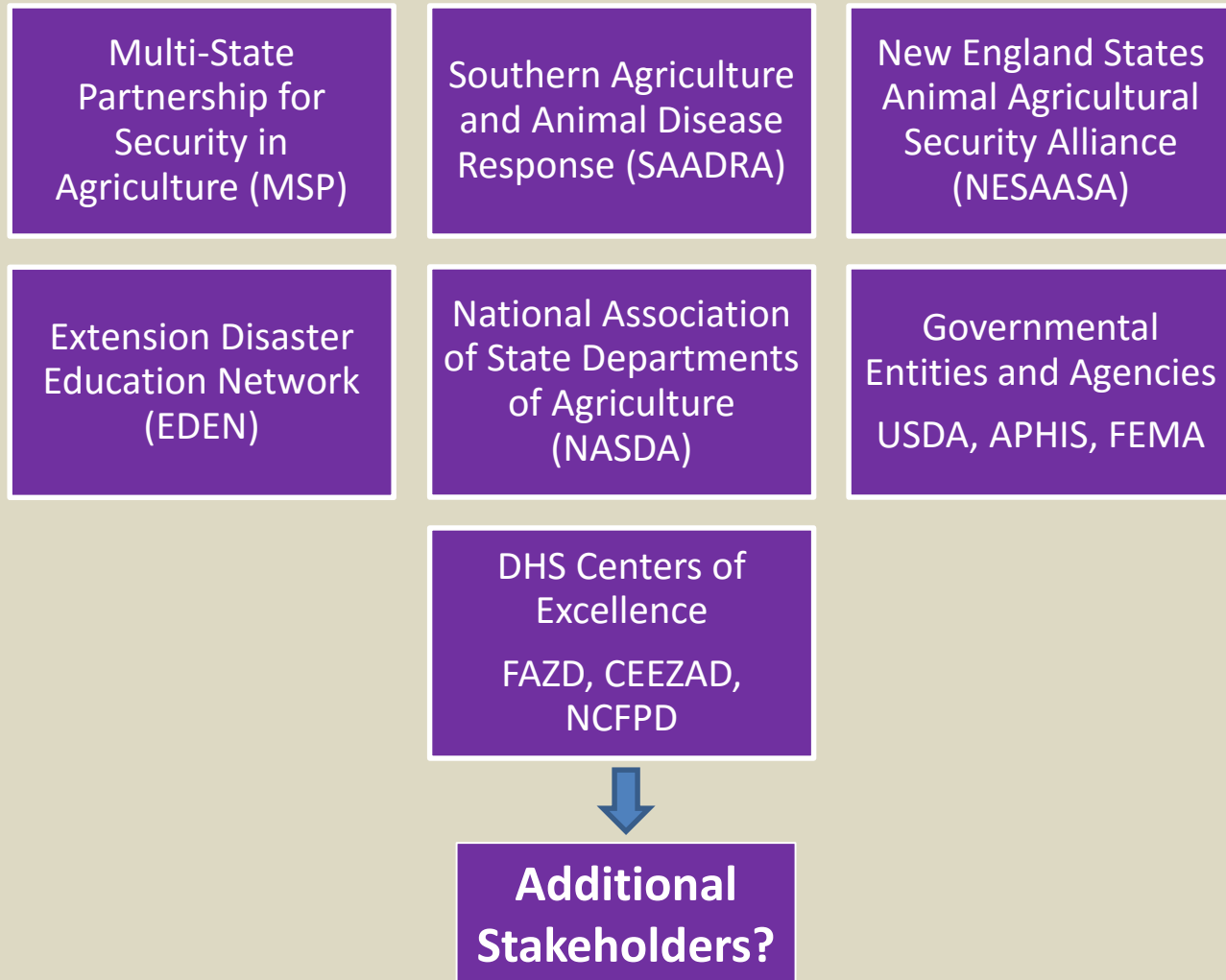


- All agent-specific plans addressed at least some of these areas

- KS included the most with 9/11

## Two Phase Project:

1. Review of existing Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) produced planning modules and documents by appropriate stakeholders to determine their value in developing guidance for a risk-informed planning process.
2. Develop a Livestock Emergency Response Plan Appendix Template for use by state, local, tribal and territorial (SLTT) government entities for the management of food and agriculture infrastructure incidents
